What is the Prayground?

The Prayground is an area in the sanctuary specifically set aside for young children during worship. There are soft, quiet toys, a table and chairs, and items for smaller infants. We want kids to know that there is a space for them in our church, and we want parents to know that we value their children!

Why is it in the front of the Sanctuary?

Kids pay more attention when they can see what's going on and they're short! We recognize kids will play and color for most of the time, but they also pay attention to and hear what's happening in worship. When they can see what's going on, they absorb things in a different way. It's important to us that our children know they are important and valued. Giving them a great view of what is happening in worship is one way to do that!

What ages is it for?

While we don't have a formal "age limit" for the Prayground, most of the toys and activities are geared towards ages 5 and below.

We ask that you help your child(ren) pick up and place items back as they found them.
